### Programs Offered

Jr. Kindergarten students attend school two days per week. We offer a two-day program and a three-day program option for kindergarten through second grade students. Third grade through twelfth grade students attend three days per week.

**Multi-student discount:** The third and each additional child will receive a 20% tuition discount, applied to each child's tuition *after* the deposit.

- Students new to 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade may be required to attend summer preparatory classes, based on entrance testing and/or Latin background. These will be an additional charge.
